Press Release: Exhibition Islam successfully completes the launch of '**Islam's relations with other Religions**' exhibition at The London Central Mosque and the Islamic Cultural Centre, London .

London, UK: Exhibition Islam and The London Central Mosque and the Islamic Cultural Centre are have successfully completed the '**Islam's relations with other Religions**' exhibition. The exhibition, which was displayed at the London Central Mosque Saturday 19th and Thursday 24th June 2010.

The exhibition was attended by a number of notable visitors such as Karen Buck MP, Sir Sigmund Sternberg, Archbishop Faustino Sainz Munoz, and many others, who praised and commended the exhibition.

Attracting thousands of visitors from all communities over 6 days, the exhibition proved how different communities could come together and agree on shared principles such as morality, peace, fairness, mercy and justice.

For the first time ever in the Europe, Jewish and Christian communities were invited to a Mosque and were given the opportunity to examine rare Torah scrolls and Bible manuscripts that were written by Jews and Christians who lived under the reign of Muslim governments in Yemen, Morocco, Iraq and many other Muslim nations. On show were rare Quranic manuscripts from around the Islamic world from the 1st century of Islam to the present day.

The exhibition went a long way to prove how Islam is a religion of justice, mercy, moderation and tolerance, and how, with these very values, Muslims ranging from the time of Early Caliphs until the final days of the Ottoman Caliphate provided sanctuary and protection to non-Muslim communities who were being persecuted in other parts of the World.
